



## THE PTE. DAVID GREENSLADE MEMORIAL BURSARY

This yearly bursary in the amount of \$1,500.00 has been established as of June 2008 in memory of Private David Robert Greenslade of the Royal Canadian Regiment (2RCR) who died on active duty with the Canadian Armed Forces in Afghanistan on Easter Sunday, April 8, 2007. David was a 2004 graduate of Saint John High School and dedicated to his country.

### ELIGIBILITY:

The recipient of this bursary will be a student at Saint John High School who fulfills at least one of the following 3 criteria:

- 1) personal involvement in the Canadian Armed Forces (e.g. cadets, reserves, or militia)
- 2) pursuing a career in the Canadian Armed Forces
- 3) has family members who either served or are presently serving in the Canadian Armed Forces.

In addition, the candidate should be an enthusiastic, personable and a respected individual who held a part-time job while attending high school. Emphasis will be placed on the fact that the recipient be a well rounded student with a good work ethic. This bursary shall not be awarded solely on marks.

### SELECTION:

Selection by the School's Scholarship Committee (Principal, Members of Administration, Guidance Counsellors, Faculty Representatives and Members of the school's Parent School Support Committee) will take place in June.

### DEADLINE:

Completed applications must be submitted to Guidance by **June 1**.
